Charities Trust

Charities Trust is a national payroll giving, corporate donation management agency approved by the Inland Revenue. Charities Trust is a non-profit making organisation, and a charity in its own right.

What is payroll giving?

- Payroll giving is a flexible scheme which allows you, (including pensioners), paid through PAYE, to give regularly and on a tax free basis to the charities of your choice.]
- Any donation will be deducted from your wages before you are assessed for tax.
- In order for you to make pre-tax donations your company will need to be registered with Charities Trust who are a payroll giving agency.
- A donation of £5.00, for example, costs you at standard rate tax, only £3.90, and if you are on the 40% tax band your donation will only cost you £3.00.

What is a Freedom Account?

The Freedom Account is a fantastic scheme that gives you the freedom of making donations whenever you want to whichever charity/good cause you decide.

The Freedom Account is part of the payroll giving scheme. All you need to do is donate a minimum of £10.00 per month. Once enrolled on the scheme you are then issued with a book of vouchers similar to a cheque book. All you need to do is simply fill out the voucher with the minimum voucher value of £5.00 and send to the charity of your choice or donate directly to charity online.

You can view your Freedom Account online at any time to check the balance of your account as well as receiving quarterly statements from Charities Trust.

As with named charity payroll donations a 25p administration fee is charged on all donations made via voucher accounts irrelevant of the amount you donate.

How can I take part?

- You can give to more than 1 charity. In addition you can donate to any registered charity or recognized good cause.
- The minimum donation is 25p per week (per charity) or £1.00 per month. There is no maximum.
- You can vary your choice of charity or stop giving at any time by simply informing your wages department and Charities Trust in writing.
